



RAYAC Housing Snapshot

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

January-September 2017 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 876 homes were sold in Adams County through September 2017, a 1% decrease from 2016. In York County 4,500 homes were sold in the first nine months of 2017, a 5% increase from 2016.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$178,737, a 2% increase from 2016. The median sale price in York County was \$166,000, a 4% increase over last year.

“September was a strong month with increases in both median sale price and number of homes sold,” said Deborah Goodling, 2017 RAYAC President. She added, “The majority of school districts are seeing an increase in sale price which is great news for potential sellers. There is still a demand for listings to accommodate buyers’ needs.”

September 2017 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 110 homes were sold in Adams County in September 2017, a 7% increase from last year. In York County 541 homes were sold in September 2017, a 7% increase from 2016.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$192,250, a 7% increase over last year. The median sale price in York County was \$169,900, a 5% increase from last year.
