

RAYAC Housing Snapshot

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

January-July 2017 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 623 homes were sold in Adams County through July 2017, a 4% decrease from 2016. In York County 3,355 homes were sold in the first seven months of 2017, a 4% increase from 2016.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$174,000, a 2% increase from 2016. The median sale price in York County was \$165,000, a 4% increase over last year.

"Sales through July are showing a steady increase for York County. We would see better increases in both counties if we had more inventory. Qualified buyers are facing challenges with a shortage of homes for sale and multiple offer situations," said Deborah Goodling, 2017 RAYAC President.

July 2017 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 87 homes were sold in Adams County in July 2017, a 19% decrease from last year. In York County 564 homes were sold in July 2017, a 1% decrease from 2016.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$180,000, a 5% decrease over last year. The median sale price in York County was \$175,000, a 2% increase from last year.
