



RAYAC Housing Snapshot

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

January-May 2017 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 428 homes were sold in Adams County through May 2017, a 9% increase from 2016. In York County 2,145 homes were sold in the first five months of 2017, a 5% increase from 2016.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$167,000, a 2% increase over 2016. The median sale price in York County was \$156,000, a 4% increase over last year.

“Year to date the housing market continues to grow in both the number of homes sold and the median sale price,” said Deborah Goodling, 2017 RAYAC President. She added, “We feel confident that increased real estate sales will extend into the summer since pending sales are up 12 percent over last year.”

May 2017 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 96 homes were sold in Adams County in May 2017, a 12% decrease from last year. In York County 577 homes were sold in May 2017, an 8% increase from 2016.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$178,127, a 6% increase over last year. The median sale price in York County was \$155,000, a 5% decrease from last year.
