



RAYAC Housing Snapshot

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

January 2017 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 58 homes were sold in Adams County in January 2017, a 21% increase from 2016. In York County 329 homes were sold in January 2017, a 14% increase from 2016.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$151,200, the same as last year. The median sale price in York County was \$168,000, a 16% increase over last year.

“The new year is off to a strong start for home sales in both counties. The mild winter definitely helped keep housing sales moving,” said Deborah Goodling, 2017 RAYAC President. She added, “Right now we are challenged with a lack of inventory. That, along with increased buyer demand, is leading to higher sale prices, especially in York County. If you’re thinking about selling your home, now would be a great time to talk to a Realtor.”
