

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

January - February 2018 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 116 homes were sold in Adams County through the end of February 2018, a 12% decrease from 2017. In York County 660 homes were sold during the first two months of 2018, the same as last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$157,500, a 2% increase from 2017. The median sale price in York County was \$164,900, a 9% increase from last year.

"We are at the lowest inventory supply since we started tracking the monthly inventory in 2011. This obviously impacts the number of home sales and sales prices. While January and February are typically slower months in the real estate business, we are gearing up for the traditionally busy spring buying and selling season," said Ken Worley, 2018 RAYAC President.

February 2018 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 48 homes were sold in Adams County in February 2018, a 31% decrease. In York County 321 homes were sold in February 2018, a 5% decrease from 2017.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$180,000, a 15% increase since last year. The median sale price in York County was \$165,000, a 4% increase from last year.
