

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

## January - March 2018 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 217 homes were sold in Adams County through the end of March 2018, a 7% decrease from 2017. In York County 1,169 homes were sold during the first three months of 2018, a 3% increase from last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$174,500, a 7% increase from 2017. The median sale price in York County was \$165,000, a 7% increase from last year.

"The lack of inventory continues to be the number one issue in the real estate market. With the prolonged winter season it has not encouraged sellers to list their homes for sale," said Ken Worley, 2018 RAYAC President. "There is healthy demand from buyers, that combined with low inventory is leading homebuyers to face fierce competition when making an offer to purchase a home."

## March 2018 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 90 homes were sold in Adams County in March 2018, a 12% decrease. In York County 476 homes were sold in March 2018, a 3% increase from 2017.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$185,500 a 4% increase since last year. The median sale price in York County was \$169,900, a 6% increase from last year.
