

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

January - April 2018 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 324 homes were sold in Adams County through the end of April 2018, a 2% decrease from 2017. In York County 1,655 homes were sold during the first four months of 2018, a 4% increase from last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$183,000, a 12% increase from 2017. The median sale price in York County was \$168,000, a 7% increase from last year.

"The lack of inventory continues to be the number one issue in the real estate market. We are starting to see an increase in the number of houses being listed for sale. However, with the demand of buyers in the marketplace, these listings are selling very quickly," said Ken Worley, 2018 RAYAC President. "According to a recent report from ATTOM Data Solutions in Pennsylvania, May through August are the best months to sell a home. If you are thinking of selling, now is the perfect time to call a REALTOR®."

April 2018 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 104 homes were sold in Adams County in April 2018, a 9% increase. In York County 461 homes were sold in April 2018, which remained the same as 2017.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$197,000 a 21% increase since last year. The median sale price in York County was \$170,200, a 5% increase from last year.
