

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

## January - August 2018 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 834 homes were sold in Adams County through the end of August 2018, a 9% increase from 2017. In York County 4,142 homes were sold during the first eight months of 2018, a 1% decrease from last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$193,000 a 10% increase from 2017. The median sale price in York County was \$175,000, a 6% increase from last year.

"York County is on pace to equal or exceed the highest median home sale price on record. In 2007 the median home sale price was \$174,900. Today it is \$175,000," said Ken Worley, RYAC 2018 President. "Anecdotally, our REALTOR® members are reporting a continued strong buyer demand as we approach the fall season."

## August 2018 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 129 homes were sold in Adams County in August 2018, a 3% decrease. In York County 593 homes were sold in August 2018, which is a 1% decrease from 2017.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$198,000 a 4% increase since last year. The median sale price in York County was \$189,900, a 12% increase from last year.
