



# RAYAC Housing Snapshot

*A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties*

## January-December 2017 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 1,266 homes were sold in Adams County in 2017, a 7% increase from 2016. In York County 6,243 homes were sold in 2017, an 11% increase from 2016.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$184,900, a 6% increase from 2016. The median sale price in York County was \$169,900, a 6% increase over last year.

“We ended 2017 on a strong note with increases in both median sale price and number of homes sold for York & Adams counties,” said Ken Worley, 2018 RAYAC President. He added, “This is the fifth year in a row with increases in sales price and the sixth year for increases in the number of homes sold for York County. As we look forward to 2018, we are optimistic with a national report stating that 76 percent of homeowners think now is a good time to list their home for sale.”

\* In 2016 these school districts were covered by two separate MLS systems; therefore, the number reported in 2016 was only a fraction of what truly sold. Now the data in Bright MLS reflects more comprehensive data from these school districts. Without Northern and West Shore numbers, York County home sales show a 6 percent increase.

## *December 2017 Housing Statistics*

The REALTORS Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 81 homes were sold in Adams County in December 2017, an 11% decrease from last year. In York County 417 homes were sold in December 2017, also an 11% decrease from 2016.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$196,000, a 19% increase over last year. The median sale price in York County was \$166,700, a 6% increase from last year.
