



# WHAT WE CARE ABOUT

#### Flood Insurance: Reauthorization

Authority for the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) to write insurance expires on May 31, 2019. Flood insurance is required for a federally-related mortgage in more than 20,000 communities across the country. According to NAR Research, 40,000 property sales are delayed or canceled each month of a program lapse. REALTORS support extending the NFIP as Congress continues its bipartisan work toward responsible long-term reauthorization that includes meaningful reforms to strengthen program solvency.

#### **Qualified Opportunity Zones: Investment Deadline Extension**

The Qualified Opportunity Zone (QOZ) program has great potential to spur the real estate development and investment, creating additional economic opportunities in these designated communities. Investors are eager to participate, but delays in the process to finalize QOZ rules have stalled the program's momentum. The U.S. Treasury and the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) must quickly finalize rulemaking, or Congress should act to extend deadlines for certain tax benefits created through Opportunity Zones to ensure the program's success.

#### Fair Housing: The Equality Act

Fair housing laws improve opportunities for employment, education, and healthy communities, and the National Association of REALTORS® is proud of our commitment to equal housing policies. Ten years ago, NAR amended its Code of Ethics to require that REALTORS® provide equal professional service to the LGBTQ population. REALTORS® support H.R. 5, The Equality Act, which amends our nation's civil rights laws to ensure the American Dream is available and accessible to all Americans.

#### From the Executive Officer

### **NAR Meeting Round Up**

Each May over 10,000 REALTORS® ascend to Washington D.C. for the NAR Legislative Meetings. It's quite the event! Members passionately discuss issues with their elected officials on legislation impacting the real estate industry. In addition to the legislative piece, there is a great deal of debate and discussion on hot topic issues facing REALTORS® across the country. Here is a brief highlight of the meetings.

Chief Economist Housing Outlook Predictions. Always one of my favorite parts of the NAR meetings is hearing the Economic Forecast from Dr. Lawrence Yun. Dr. Yun is predicting moderate housing market growth for 2020. He is predicting existing home sales up 4%, median sales price up 3.3% and he is predicting the 30 year-rate at 4.6%. You can view his entire presentation by clicking here.

**Legal Action**. NAR Board of Directors approved legal action funding on three cases: two involve defense of brokerages classifying agents as independent contractors (one in California and one in New Jersey); one supports a defendant in a copyright action.

**Professional Standards.** Approved a change to Standard of Practice 1-7 that clarifies that the practice of providing a timely written affirmation to the cooperating broker is a tool to reassure buyers and cooperating brokers that offers were handled properly. The change is effective Jan. 1, 2020.

**NAR Financials**. NAR dues will remain at \$150 for 2020, with \$40 of this amount allocated for REALTOR® Party Programs. NAR forecasts 1.34 million REALTOR® members in 2020.

# **Practicing Professionalism**

Case #1-3: Net Listing

Client A called REALTOR® B to list a small commercial property, explaining that he wanted to net at least \$170,000 from its sale. He inquired about the brokerage commission and other selling costs. REALTOR® B's response was: "You have indicated that \$170,000 net to you from the sale will be satisfactory. Suppose we just leave it at that and take all of the selling costs from the proceeds of the sale above \$170,000." Client A agreed.

The property was sold to Buyer C for \$220,000. After settlement, in which it was apparent that \$50,000 would go to REALTOR® B as commission, Client A and Buyer C both complained to the Board of REALTORS® about REALTOR® B's conduct in the matter, and a hearing was scheduled before the Board's Professional Standards Committee.

REALTOR® B's defense was that he had performed the service that Client A engaged him for precisely in conformance with their agreement. Buyer C had considered the property a good buy at \$220,000 and was happy with the transaction until he learned the amount of the commission.

The Hearing Panel found REALTOR® B in violation of Article 1 of the Code. The panel concluded that REALTOR® B had departed completely from his obligation to render a professional service in fidelity to his client's interest; that he had, in fact, been a speculator in his client's property; and that he had not dealt honestly with either party to the transaction.
