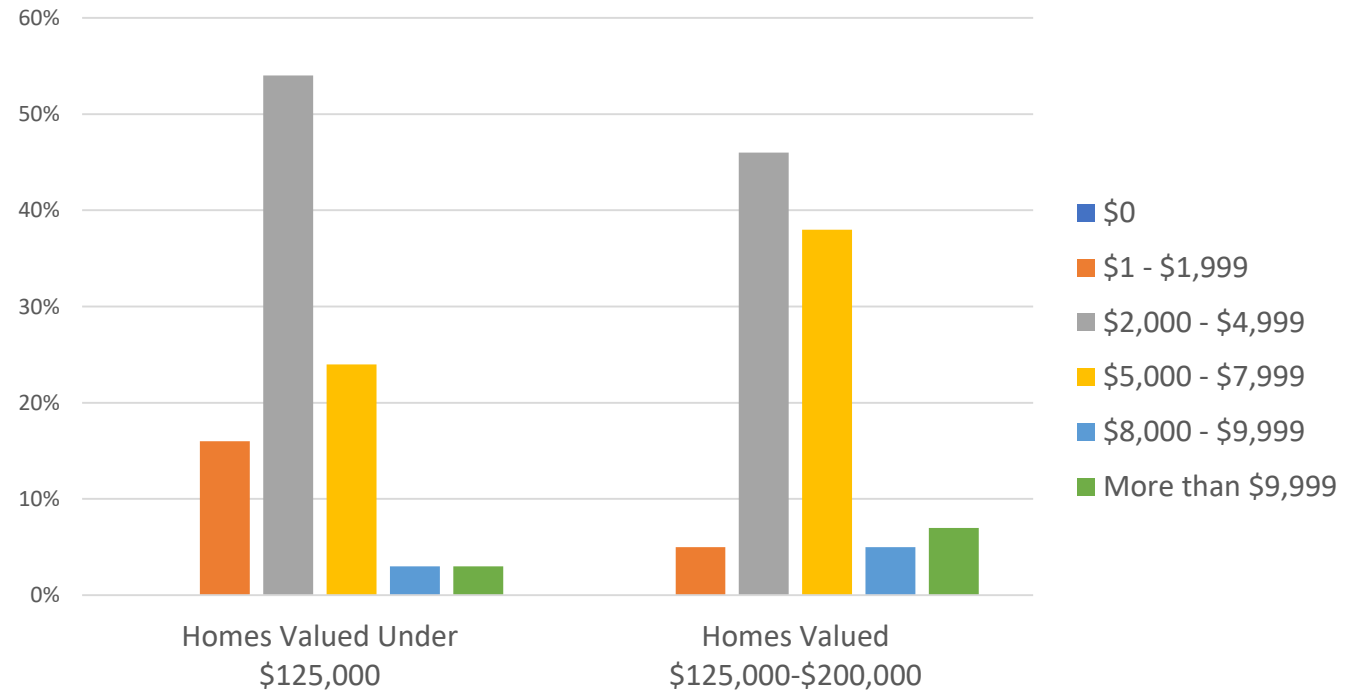

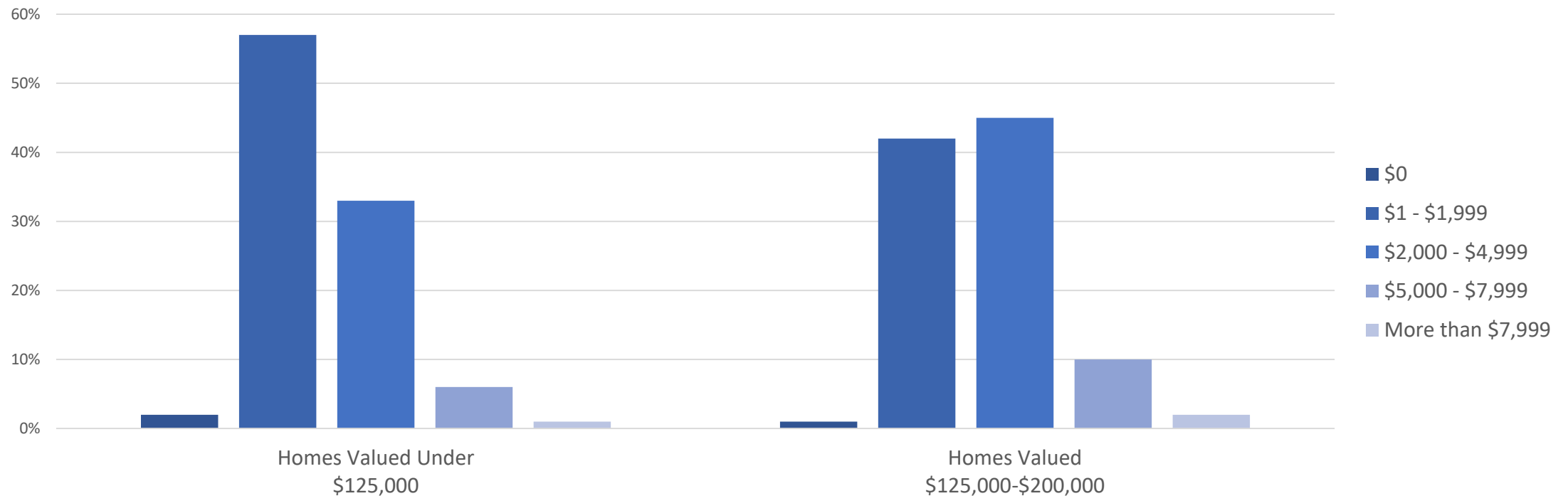
Assuming a house has one full bathroom, how much would a typical buyer pay for an additional bathroom above grade?

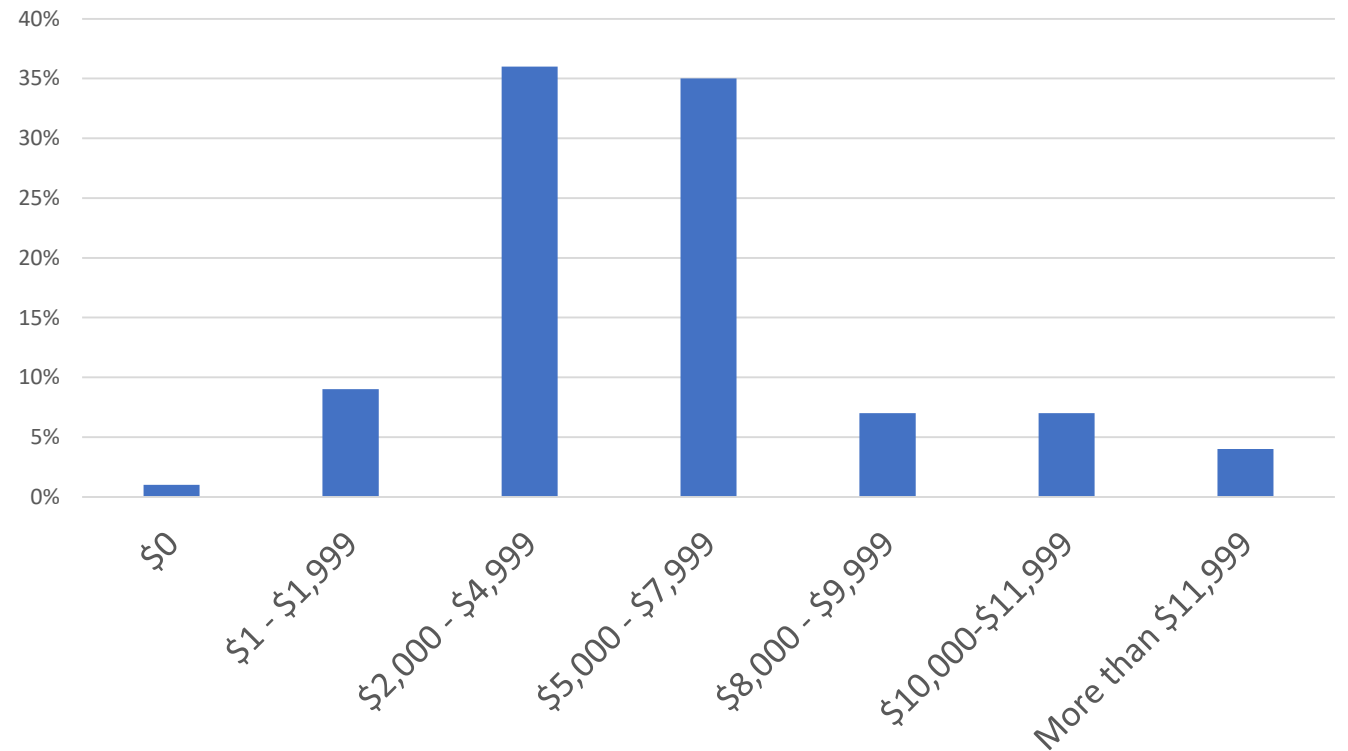
# Half Baths in homes valued up to \$200,000

Assuming a house has one full bathroom, how much would a typical buyer pay for an additional **half bath** above grade?



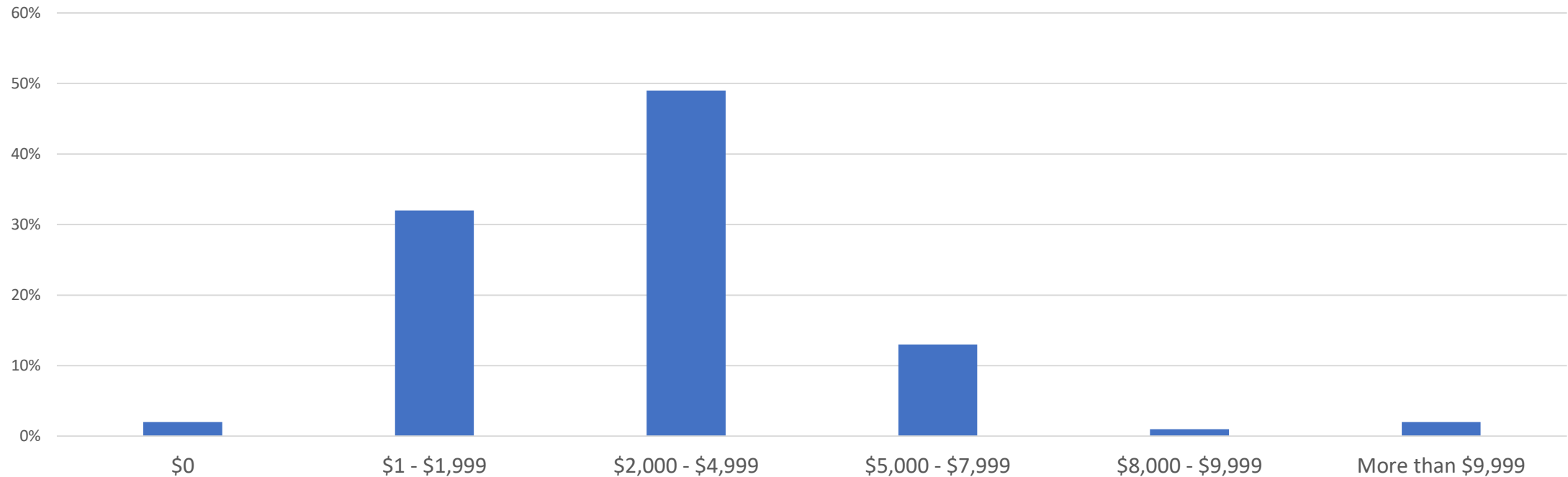
# Full Bathrooms in homes valued \$200,000- \$350,000

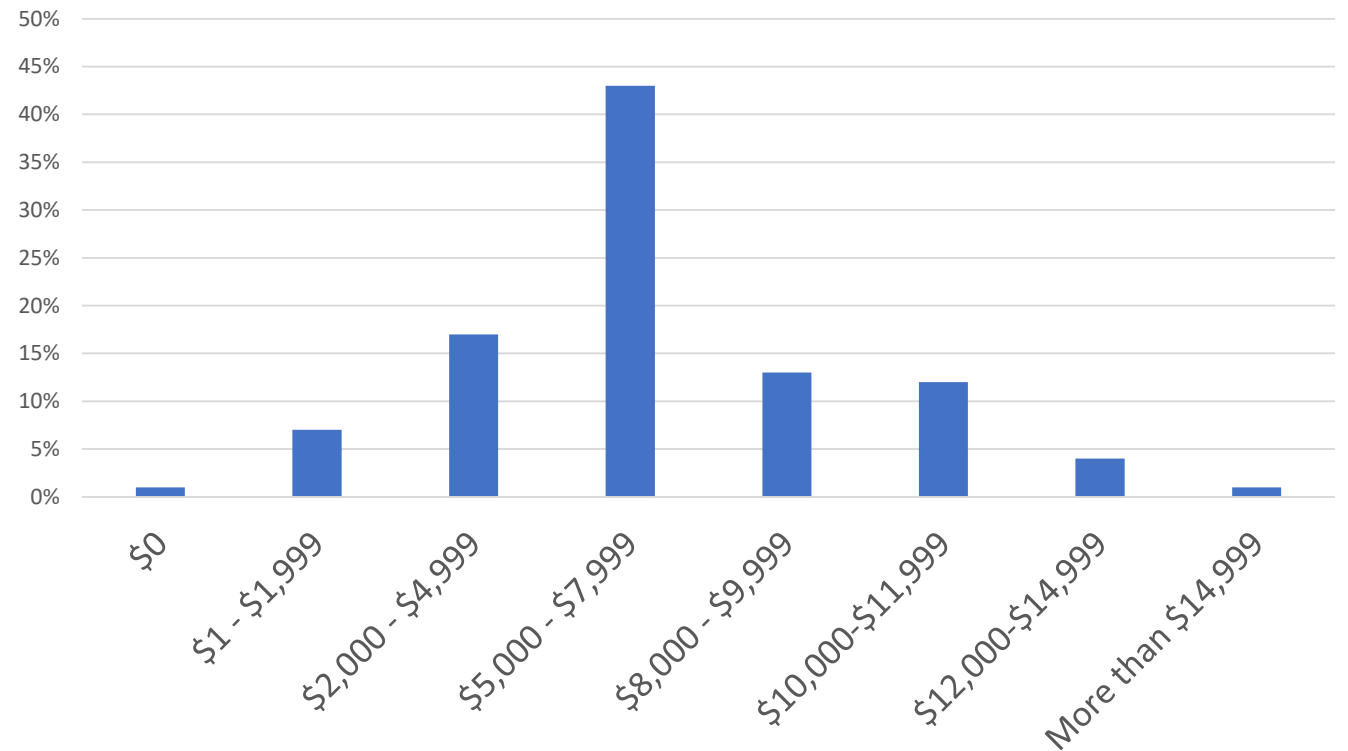
# Half Baths in Homes Valued between \$200,000-\$350,000

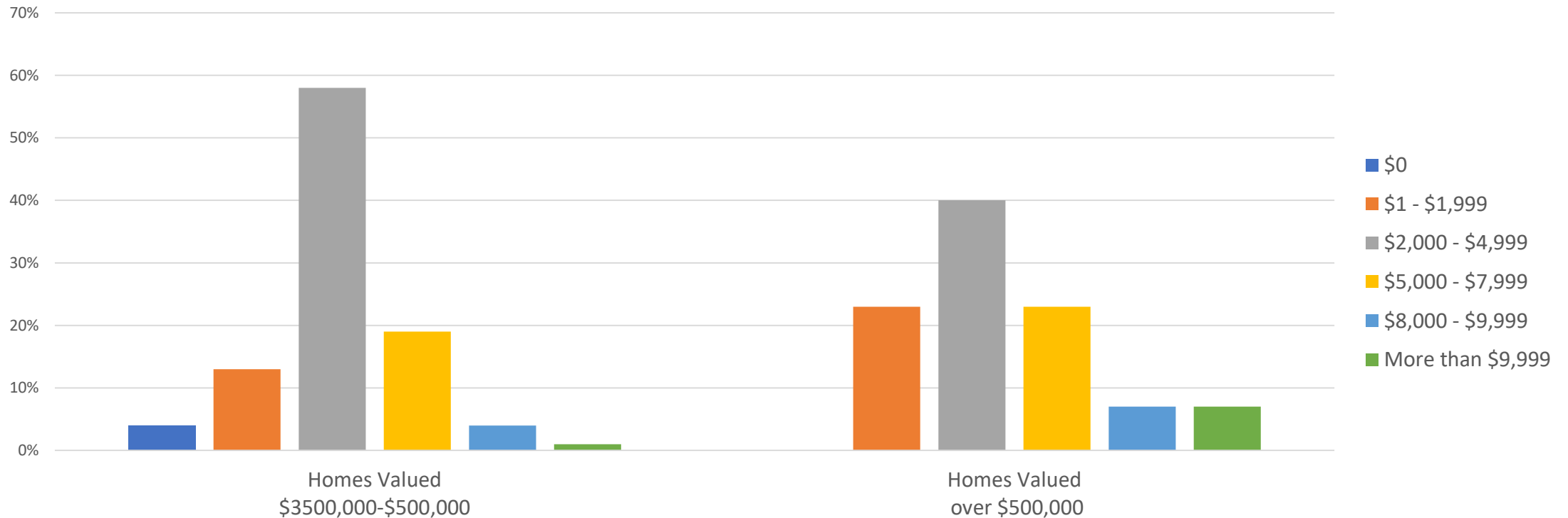
# Full Bathrooms in homes valued \$350,000- \$500,000
