

RAYAC Housing Snapshot

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

March 2020 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 237 homes were sold in Adams County through the end of March 2020, a 7% increase from 2019. In York County 1,277 homes were sold during the first three months of 2020, a 2% increase from last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$203,000 a 13% increase from 2019. The median sales price in York County was \$179,500, a 3% increase from last year.

"Governor Tom Wolf ordered a shutdown of non-life sustaining businesses on March 19th due to the Covid-19 health crisis. Real estate was classified by the Governor as a non-life sustaining industry. The numbers we are reporting today are from home sales through March 31st. The vast majority of these home sales were settled prior to March 19th. The impacts of the current pandemic on the real estate market are yet to be seen. What we do know is going into the pandemic we had one of the strongest real estate markets in our history for York & Adams Counties. That will serve us well as we work through the implications of these unchartered waters." said Sue Pindle, 2020 RAYAC President.



The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 88 homes were sold in Adams County in March 2020, a 1% increase. In York County 525 homes were sold in March 2020, a 2% increase from 2019.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$200,000, which remains the same as this time last year. The median sale price in York County was \$182,350, a 1% increase from last year.


