

RAYAC Housing Snapshot

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

April 2020 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 340 homes were sold in Adams County through the end of April 2020, a 10% increase from 2019. In York County 1,712 homes were sold during the first four months of 2020, a 1% decrease from last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$215,000 a 17% increase from 2019. The median sales price in York County was \$184,900, a 6% increase from last year.

"It is important to keep in my mind with the statistics we are reporting today while seeming very positive for the real estate industry, the vast majority of these home sales through the end of April were under contract prior to the Governor's shutdown orders. On March 19, 2020 Governor Wolf ordered the shutdown of all non-life sustaining businesses in Pennsylvania. Since the state's business shutdown, Gov. Wolf has deemed real estate a non-life sustaining business, which has caused a significant hardship for Pennsylvanians. We are shocked to see the governor continues to fail to recognize the need for consumers to buy and sell their homes. As it stands today Pennsylvania is the only state in the Country who has deemed real estate as a non-essential business on a statewide basis. As REALTORS® we have been advocating to make real estate a life sustaining business. I believe, like most other states, that real estate professionals can safely conduct business for their clients. We are not suggesting a return to "business as usual." We recognize that the environment has changed and real estate professionals are ready to adapt to make these changes. Gov. Wolf needs to immediately reopen real estate on a statewide basis said Sue Pindle, 2020 RAYAC President.


RAYAC Statistics by School District 2020-2019 (January 1-April 30) Comparison

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 103 homes were sold in Adams County in April 2020, a 20% increase. In York County 427 homes were sold in April 2020, a 7% decrease from 2019.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$219,900, a 13% increase from this time last year. The median sale price in York County was \$205,000, a 17% increase from last year.


