

RAYAC Housing Snapshot

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

June 2021 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 589 homes were sold in Adams County through the end of June 2021, a 27% increase from 2020. In York County 3,243 homes were sold during the first six months of 2021, a 31% increase from last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$240,000 a 12% increase from 2020. The median sales price in York County was \$213,900, a 13% increase from last year.

"June is typically one of the busiest home buying months of the year. The demand for a home purchase is widespread, multiple offers are prevalent and days on market are swift. But the continued story surrounding real estate is a lack of inventory." said Elle Hale, 2021 RAYAC Vice-President. "As a result of the buyer demand, coupled with a continued lack of supply, we are seeing an increase in median home sale prices."

**Please note - Last year at this time the Pennsylvania Administration had shut down in-person real estate activity through mid-May. Some of the big jumps in the month to month are a reflection of that shut down.

June 2021 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 125 homes were sold in Adams County in June 2021, which is a 105% increase from last year. In York County 667 homes were sold in June 2021, which is a 38% increase from last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$265,000, an 18% increase from last year. The median sale price in York County was \$228,000, an 11% increase from last year.
