

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

April 2022 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 348 homes were sold in Adams County in April 2022, which is the same as this time last year. In York County 1,949 homes were sold during the first four months of 2022, which is a 1% decrease from this time last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$265,270, a 13% increase from 2021. The median sales price in York County was \$226,000, an 8% increase from last year.

"A lack of inventory continues to be an issue driving the home buying market. For the first time this year, the number of home sales is slightly less than the same time period last year in York County. As interest rates have risen over 5% and home sale prices continuing to escalate, our concern is housing affordability. According to statistics compiled by the National Association REALTORS®, purchasing a home is 55% more expensive than a year ago." said Elle Hale, 2022 RAYAC President.

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 108 homes were sold in Adams County in April 2022, a 14% increase from this time last year. In York County 532 homes were sold in April 2022, which is a 6% decrease from last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$281,000 a 13% increase since last year. The median sale price in York County was \$229,450, a 5% increase from last year.
