

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

July 2022 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 721 homes were sold in Adams County in July 2022, which is a 2% increase from this time last year. In York County 3,833 homes were sold during the first seven months of 2022, which is a 4% decrease from this time last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$279,000, a 16% increase from 2021. The median sales price in York County was \$241,500, an 11% increase from last year.

"The real estate market has had a small shift in York County. With the rise in interest rates over 5%, the number of home sales in York County has a small decline year to date compared to 2021. It is important to keep in mind that 2021 was an exceptional year breaking the record of the number of home sales ever recorded in York County. The median home sale price continues to rise in both counties. According to our predictions the median home sale price will continue to increase in York & Adams Counties through 2023." said Elle Hale, 2022 RAYAC President.

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 107 homes were sold in Adams County in July 2022, which is a 6% decrease from this time last year. In York County 590 homes were sold in July 2022, which is a 20% decrease from last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$295,000 a 19% increase since last year. The median sale price in York County was \$250,000, a 6% increase from last year.


