

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

## March 2023 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 200 homes were sold in Adams County in March 2023, a 16% decrease from 2022. In York County 1,084 homes were sold during the first three months of 2023, which is a 23% decrease from this time last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$269,950, a 6% increase from 2022. The median sales price in York County was \$249,490, an 11% increase from last year.

"Inventory continues to be the main theme of the real estate market. In York County the months supply of inventory is still below the historically low one-month mark. If we take out new construction homes, there are only 225 homes available for sale in all of York County. That simply is not enough to meet the housing demands of our population. One of the main reasons behind the decrease in the number of home sales in our community is a lack of inventory." said Reid Weinbrom, 2023 RAYAC President.

## March 2023 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 94 homes were sold in Adams County in March 2023, which is the same as this time last year. In York County 442 homes were sold in March 2023, which is a 15% decrease from last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$274,950 a 3% increase since last year. The median sale price in York County was \$261,000, a 4% increase from last year.
