

## **RAYAC Housing Snapshot**

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

## **December 2024 Housing Statistics**

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 1,020 homes were sold in Adams County through December 2024, which is a 2% decrease from this time last year. In York County 5,607 homes were sold during the year, a 4% increase from 2023.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$320,000, an 11% increase from 2023. The median sales price in York County was \$275,000, a 4% increase from last year.

"The York County housing market outperformed national trends in 2024, achieving a 4% increase in sales compared to 2023. The median home sale price reached a historic high of \$275,000, reflecting a remarkable 49% growth over the past five years. Looking ahead to 2025, we anticipate continued moderate increases in both home prices and sales activity. As the market remains nuanced—with some homes selling quickly while others take slightly longer—it's more important than ever to work with a real estate professional who can guide you through the process," stated 2025 RAYAC President Selina Robinson.

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 85 homes were sold in Adams County in December 2024, a 21% increase from this time last year. In York County 457 homes were sold in December 2024, which is a 3% increase from this time last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$327,000 a 9% increase since last year. The median sale price in York County was \$275,000, which is a 4% increase from this time last year.
