

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

June 2025 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 504 homes were sold in Adams County in June 2025, a 10% increase from 2024. In York County 2,506 homes were sold during the first six months of 2025, which is a 4% decrease from this time last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$327,000, a 2% increase from 2024. The median sales price in York County was \$287,900, a 7% increase from last year.

"Despite a slightly slower first half of the year, both counties reached record highs for their median home sale prices. While sales have been a little slower this spring in York County, Adams County is trending in the opposite direction, with increases in both closed and pending sales. Buyers are still active in the market, and although inventory has ticked up slightly, it remains low by historical standards—still about half of what it was in 2019 for both counties." said RAYAC President Selina Robinson.

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 118 homes were sold in Adams County in June 2025, a 28% increase from this time last year. In York County 474 homes were sold in June 2025, which is a 11% decrease from last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$350,000 a 2% decrease since last year. The median sale price in York County was \$300,000, which is a 5% increase from this time last year.
