



RAYAC Housing Snapshot

A review of the residential real estate market in York & Adams Counties

December 2025 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 1,130 homes were sold in Adams County in December 2025, an 11% increase from 2024. In York County 5,548 homes were sold during 2025, which is a 1% decrease from this time last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$335,000, a 5% increase from 2024. The median sales price in York County was \$294,900, a 7% increase from last year.

“As we close out the 2025 real estate market, York County reached another milestone with the median home sale price climbing to just under \$295,000. This marks the 12th consecutive year of price appreciation locally, and since the pandemic we’ve seen prices increase by 47%. While the total number of homes sold dipped slightly from last year, sales were still up more than 2% compared to 2023, signaling continued demand. Looking ahead, national economists are forecasting that a combination of increased housing inventory and a modest easing of mortgage interest rates could make 2026 a strong and more balanced year for real estate”, stated 2026 RAYAC President Allison Altman.

December 2025 Housing Statistics

The REALTORS® Association of York & Adams Counties (RAYAC) reports that a total of 109 homes were sold in Adams County in December 2025, a 28% increase from this time last year. In York County 512 homes were sold in December 2025, which is a 12% increase from last year.

The median sales price in Adams County was \$315,000 a 4% decrease since last year. The median sale price in York County was \$297,800, which is an 8% increase from this time last year.






